

About Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir

The Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir is a distinguished and renowned Educational Institute in Maharashtra and has done pioneering work in the field of education. The institute has been registered under Society's Registration Act of 1860 and Bombay Public Trust Act of 1950.

Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir was established on 2nd October 1952 by Founder, Late Karmaveer Bhausaheb Hiray, the Sculptor of Modern Maharashtra, a Staunch Freedom Fighter, Pioneer of Tenancy Act and Cooperative Movement and Former Revenue Minister of the then Bombay Province. He founded two Educational Institutions 'Adivasi Seva Samiti' and 'Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir' in 1945 and 1952 respectively. He was a Visionary Educationist, who was greatly inspired by the life and ideology of Father of the Nation and therefore the Institution is named after him as Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir.

The Motto of Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir is 'बहुजन हिताय, बहुजन सुखाय' (The Welfare of the Masses). The main objective of the Institute has been to bring the downtrodden and socio-economically backward sections of the society into mainstream of education by providing them educational facilities. Accordingly, the Institute has been imparting quality education to the marginalized since last seven decades.

After the demise of Karmaveer Bahusaheb Hiray, Late Loknete Vyankatrao Hiray took over the responsibility of the Institution. Under his guidance, Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir entered into professional and Technical Education, in accordance with the changing need of the time. After his unfortunate demise, Hon'ble Smt. Pushpatai Hiray (Former Minister of Health, Maharashtra State) contributed substantially for the progress of the Institute. Hon'ble Samajshree Dr. Prashantdada Hiray, General Secretary of Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir (former Minister of Maharashtra State for Transport), further expanded the Institute by establishing Professional Colleges to widen the









scope of career selection and to satisfy the growing demands for Professional Courses.

Subsequently, he established the renowned educational institute Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir in 1952 at Malegaon. The institute has spread its roots in diverse fields of education. Arts, Science and Commerce College, Manmad was founded by Loknete Vyankatraoji Hiray in 1969 with the vision to provide the students of Manmad and nearby rural regions the opportunity to pursue higher education at their doorstep. This provided the students an opportunity to excel in their respective fields of interest and pave way to their hidden potential.

The college runs different courses under Arts, Science and Commerce stream as a part of traditional education. However, the college is building a strong bond between traditional education and skilled based education. It has recently started skill based courses; Software Development and System Administration, Electronic Instruments Maintenance and Food Processing, Medical Lab and Molecular Diagnostic Technology and Banking and Financial Services under B.Voc. and Community college respectively. The college has done every effort to bring in new courses that would enable the students of rural areas to compete in the professional world. The college has recently got associated with MOOCNPTEL/Swayam as a local chapter which offers online courses conducted by reputed IITs of the nation.

The college has 29 well qualified teaching faculties. They try at their best to make the process of teaching, learning student centric. The college is likely to start a PG course in Organic Chemistry. They also have keen interest to participate in academic events at national and international levels to upgrade themselves. The college has 05 post graduate department viz. Marathi, Hindi, English, Economic and Commerce.







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The college was conferred upon the status of 'A' grade in the second cycle of accreditation by NAAC. It has all geared up to undergo the third cycle of accreditation to continue its efforts to maintain the mark of excellence. The college is striving hard to establish its own brand in sports. In realization of its efforts, a number of students have excelled on the National and International platform in sports. The college attempts to provide state-of the art sports facilities to the students.

In its social commitment, the college is keen on putting extra efforts on making the whole campus green. As a result, the campus is blooming with greenery all around it. The college is reaccredited with 'A' grade in the second cycle of NAAC. It offers UG & PG programmes in all three streams. The first PG programme of the college was introduced in 1989 and today there are 06 PG courses in the college. Keeping abreast of time, the college also offers job oriented vocational diploma and degree courses in different fields. Under B.Voc. we have degree courses in Computer Hardware, Electronic Instrument Repairing and Maintenance, Under Community College we offer Diploma courses in Food Processing Technology, Medical Laboratory and Molecular Diagnostic, Banking and Finance and English for Business and Competitive Exam. We also offer free of cost computer training for our students through a tie- up with NGO. It offers a Certificate Course in Basic Computing of six months. The college has the centre of YCMOU that facilitates opportunities of learning through Distant Education. Taking cognizance of the modern technology, we also facilitate online courses to our students with collaboration with Swayam and NPTEL. We take utmost care of availing all the central and State Govt. as well as UGC scholarship schemes to our Students.

We have an efficient Sport Department that supports' representation of our students in competitions at State and University levels. The Board of Student Development implements various useful schemes for our students. The extension activities through NSS and NCC help students to reach to the society to understand and find out solutions to the social problems. The activities of the Dept. of Extra Mural bring together all sectors of the society for better dialogue. As a part of our social welfare activity, we are connected with 24 neighboring high-schools to provide laboratory facility to them so that they can have hands on experience. Since we have more number of girl-students, we undertake to empowering women by different means like awareness campaign and special educational program for them. Even though the college is situated in rural area which has also been long affected by draught, yet it has mobilized a conducive learning environment. The campus is almost of six acres with an enriched library with e –book facility, well equipped science laboratory and Green Gym. We try to avail all facilities to our students coming from below poverty line and agriculture background.

We have a registered alumni association. It includes the dignitaries of respective position and caliber of the society. The alumni also contributes to the development of the college. Our focus has been to impart quality based education and therefore we bring together all our alumni and stakeholders to get insights from them. We follow a standard syllabus designed by the scholars and prescribed by SPPU. 

Eligibility Conditions, Admission Cancellation and Refund of Fees

- **A) Admission :** Admission to all the first year courses will be done according to NEP guidelines as per merit at H.S.C. examination, Norms and rules of S.P. University, Pune and Govt. of Maharashtra & Management of College.
- 1. The student must have passed H.S.C. examination or any equivalent examination of authentic and Government recognized body.
- 2. Student should apply in the prescribed form with necessary certificate of eligibility and fees for admission.
- 3. Students from other colleges affiliated to S.P. University Pune will seek admission directly. However, they will have to obtain Transference certificate from the previously attended college.
- 4. A student migrating from other Universities of Maharashtra and out of Maharashtra should apply in the prescribed form for the 'Eligibility Certificate' with necessary fees.
- 5. All the fresh admissions shall be provisional and will be confirmed only after the receipt of Eligibility Certificate from the S.P. University, Pune
- 6. First year students will have to undergo compulsory medical check-up.

B) Documents Required:

- 1) Statement of Marks and Passing Certificate
- 2) Leaving Certificate (L.C.)/Transfer Certificate (T.C.) (All these documents shall be produced in original at the time of admission for verification)
- 3) Migration Certificate (in case of student from other Universities)
- 4) Caste Certificate
- 5) Affidavit regarding gap in education and /or change of name in original on 100/- rupees stamp paper.
- 6) Latest three passport size photographs. Note: All the documents should be submitted with two attested photocopies.







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C) Important Instructions:

- 1) The student seeking admission in this college is liable to pay fees for the whole term.
- 2) The student seeking concession EBC/PTW/STW in fees and / or applying for scholarship should submit the forms along with relevant documents.
- 3) The student SC/ST/NT/OBC applying for scholarship/freeship should submit the forms along with related documents.
- 4) At the time of seeking admission at S.Y. level, the student should have passed F.Y. examination or A.T.K.T. at F.Y. level. To get admission in T.Y. classes the student must have passed in all the subjects of F.Y. level.
- **D)** A full refund of fees shall be made on account of cancellation of admission / migration of students up to 30 Sept. 2024 with a deduction of Rs. 1000/- (One Thousand) as a processing fee.



In 1920, when the Indian Territorial Act was passed, the 'University Corps' was replaced by the 'University Training Corps (UTC)' in 1942; the UTC was renamed as the 'University Officers Training Corps' (UOTC). The need to create a youth organization at National level to train the young boys and girls to be better citizens and future leaders of our great country in all walks of life, including Defense forces, was rightly realized by our leaders. A Committee under Pandit HN Kunzru was set up in 1946 at the behest of our first Prime Minister, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru. The NCC came into existence on 16th July, 1948 under the NCC Act XXXVI of 1948 under the Ministry of Defense (MOD)

Anti-raging

> PROHIBITION OF RAGGING IN THE COLLEGE

- 1) Anti-Ragging Committee is constituted according to the guidelines given in UGC Regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in educational institutions, 2009.
- 2) Information regarding total prohibition of ragging in the college premises is displayed by using banners, flex boards and notices. It includes that ragging is totally prohibited in the college and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with the UGC regulations as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force. Contact numbers of Anti-Ragging Committee members are displayed using banners, flex boards and notices.
- 3) The same information is also included in prospectus of the college and college website.
- 4) Telephone numbers of the Anti-Ragging Helpline and all the important functionaries in the college are included in the prospectus, banners, flex boards and notices.
- 5) Filled and Signed Affidavits are collected at the time of admission to any class in the college from the students and parents regarding non involvement in any form of ragging in and outside the college campus.
 - 6) Meeting of Anti-ragging committee is to be held at the time of commencement of the academic session and at the end of the academic session.
 - 7) Special lectures and guidance are arranged for the students to prohibit ragging in the college
 - 8) Induction programmes are arranged for the newly admitted students in the college where all sorts of information are provided regarding anti-ragging.
 - 9) Anti-ragging squad is established for raids and frequent surprise visits in the college campus to maintain healthy interpersonal relations among students and to prevent any kind of ragging.
 - 10) If any kind of ragging is observed or complaint regarding ragging in any form filled by any student of the college the Anti-Ragging Committee will take action against it in consultation of Principal of the college.
 - 11) If necessary, the Principal of the college will provide information to the local police and local authorities regarding ragging cases in the college premises.





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Women Grievance Redressal Cell

> Women Grievance Redressal Cell has been constitutes for redressal of the female students, staff and faculty members in the college campus.
