Abstract

The Agricultural Regionalization is a very important fact to the farmers help in taking decision for crop cultivation and this may be done with the help of different methods like Cropping Pattern, Crop Combination, Crop Concentration, Patterns of Crop Rotation etc. The Study identifies the basic crop combination in Nashik District, which basically an agriculture dominated area. Normally crops are grown in a Combination rather than single. Here the study will help in understanding the degree

of areal strength and significance of individual crop to advocate suitable measures as well as some strategies for well define production of a particular crop. The present study is based upon the data collected from District Statistical Handbook of Nashik District and the Method has been adopted to calculate the value belongs to Weaver's Method.
